**THE 39th ANNUAL PARK CITY KIMBALL ARTS FESTIVAL CULMINATES WITH PARK CITY LOCAL WINNING
KEN GARFF AUTOMOBILE**

PARK CITY, Utah (September 2008) – The 39th Annual Park City Kimball Arts Festival culminated in exciting fashion when long-time Park City resident David Belz won the opportunity drawing for a car donated by Ken Garff Automotive Group.

"I've lived and worked in Park City for nearly 20 years now and Arts Fest is an exciting part of summer that I look forward to every year," said Belz, owner of The Shop yoga studio. "I participate every year in the festival and to win the car was just incredible.

"I've been a member of the Kimball Art Center for the last five years and I think what they do there is a wonderful contribution to this community."

Belz was actually home when his name was drawn and received word via a phone call and ran down to the art center to celebrate the good news. He had his choice of automobile from four Ken Garff dealerships including Mercedes-Benz, Audi, Volvo and Saab. With the help of Ken Garff Mercedes-Benz sales representative Mark H. Raleigh, Belz chose a previously-owned Mercedes-Benz R-Class 320 CDI diesel.

This vehicle gets about 24 miles to the gallon and can run on bio-diesel. I like the idea of being able to use alternative fuels and hope that we'll have even more choices for alternative fuels in the future."

Belz was entered in the drawing by purchasing a \$75 "Festival Membership," which are available only during the festival.

"We're just thrilled that a committed Kimball Art Center patron and longtime Park City resident won this year's automobile from Ken Garff," Bruce Larabee, Kimball Art Center executive director. "It was a very gratifying, satisfying way to end another successful Art Festival."
