Go Wild with Robert Glenn Ketchum's: *from/for Nature*

PARK CITY, UT (April 22, 2008) – Artist, writer, and conservation advocate, Robert Glenn Ketchum is featured in the Main Gallery at the Kimball Art Center from June 6, 2008 to July 21, 2008. Ketchum's exhibit, *from/for Nature* includes contemporary landscape photographs and nature inspired embroideries on an epic scale.

Ketchum, one of the best-known contemporary color landscape photographers of our time, will present an Art Talk and Book Signing at the Kimball Art Center on Friday, June 6, 2008 from 5:00 pm – 6:00 pm. This will be followed by a reception.

A fellow of the International League of Conservation Photographers, Ketchum has been given the United Nations Outstanding Environmental Achievement Award, the Ansel Adams Award for Conservation Photography, and the Robert O. Easton Award for Environmental Stewardship. He is a lifetime trustee of the Alaska Conservation Foundation, on the Board of Councilors for the American Land Conservancy, and for 15 years served as curator of photography for the National Park Foundation.
