Time for Tea: Teaching about Teapots

Park City, UT, April 4, 2008 – In conjunction with the exhibit, *Teapots: Object to Subject*, Jenny Diersen, Education Director at the Kimball Art Center created curricula to enhance understanding of the exhibition and distributed it, free of charge, to teachers in the Park City School District, North Summit School District, South Summit School District and Wasatch School District.

Diersen, an experienced art educator, reviewed the Utah State Core Curriculum and provided teachers with grade level lesson plans that matched the required learning outcomes for students.
